## Carbon Neutrality in South-East Asia: A policy perspective

The world is not on track to limit warming to 1.5 °C and this target is increasingly becoming challenging with slow climate actions leading to continuous rise in GHG emissions. South-East Asian countries have made NDCs, carbon neutrality and net-zero pledges at various levels and timeframes followed by varying strategies. This talk presents a holistic insight on the state of emissions in South-East Asian countries, their key imperatives, emission-economic interlinkages, and key policy challenges towards achieving long-term carbon neutrality and net-zero targets.
